Short stories and poems by young refugees in New Zealand

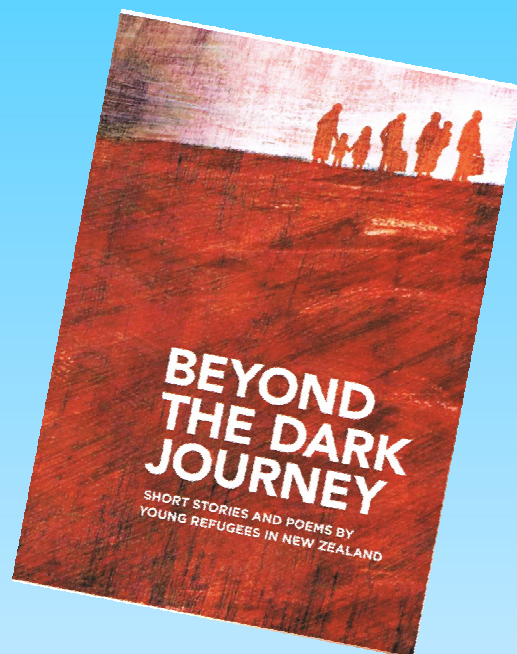
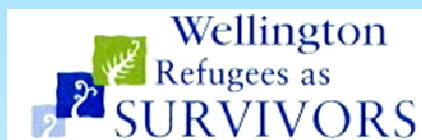
Beyond the dark journey is the eagerly anticipated follow up to Earthless Trees which was published in late 2008 and had record sales for a publication of its kind. Over 1,500 copies sold. Dame Fiona Kidman had this to say within the Preface she wrote for Earthless Trees "Above all, these are well written, accessible stories set in a modern contemporary world"
